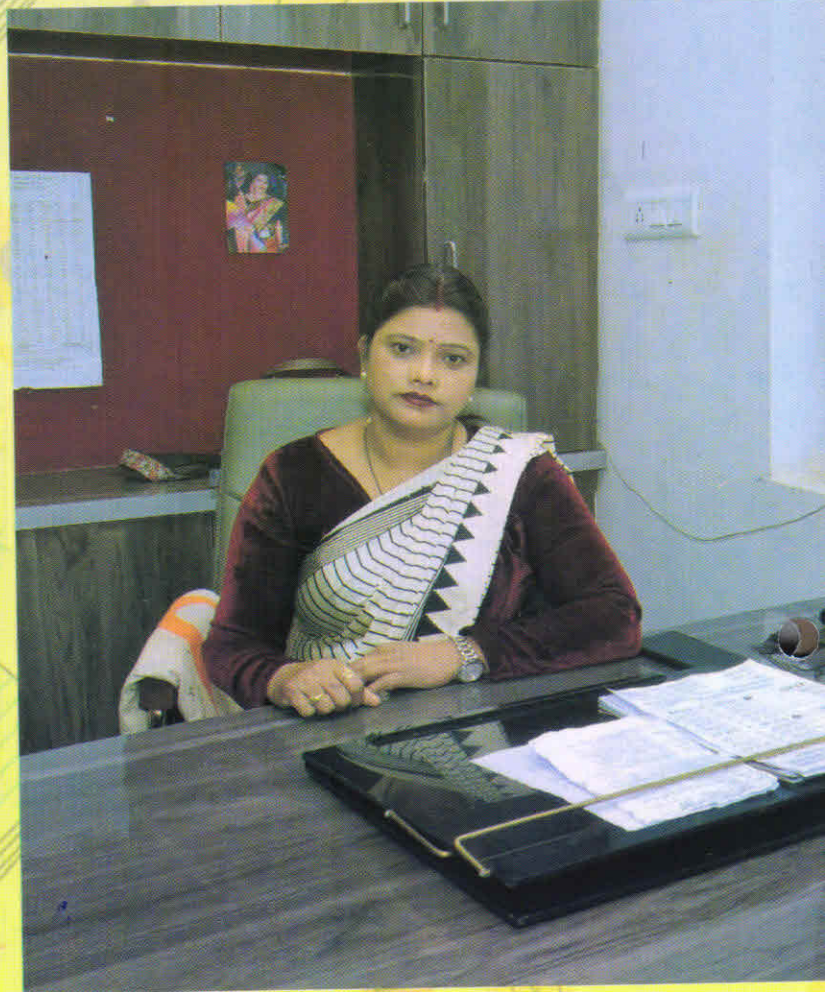
Vision

General Information

Gurukul Enlightened Public school is an English Medium co-educational school. The school has classes from Play-way to IX & XI . The school was founded in the year 2007 in fond memory of late Chunni Lal Chauhan resident of Mirzapur, Pachperwa, Gorakhnath, Gorakhpur, U.P. who was a social worker and was concerned about the upliftment of the weaker section of the society through education. To fulfil his ambition Gurukul Enlightened Public School was established by his son Mr. Indar Singh, who himself believes in the service of God through the service of people.

The school strives for excellence through hard work and discipline. It is amply demonstrated by its motto "Success Through Effort".



School Location

The school is situated in Shantipuram, near Ranisati Mandir, Nakaha Road, Gorakhnath, Gorakhpur. A neat and clean surrounding is maintained both in and out side the school building. Care is taken to see that the students find school environment pleasant to study and learn. Cleanliness and hygiene is given highest priority.

Value-Oriented School Atmosphere

At Gurukul Enlightned Public School, the children inculcate a value system to become more caring, cultured and law abiding citizens.

Admission

Admission in Gurukul Enlightened Public School is open to all who fulfil and qualify the admission criteria.

- (i) There is no written test or interview for Play-way class. We have an informal introduction with the child and the parents

Proof of age has to be provided in form of a birth certificate or transfer certificate.

- (iii) Admission test will be conducted by the school on the dates notified by the Principal.
 - (iv) A written test in Maths and English Grammar of the previous class is compulsory to test child' s level of knowledge for a particular class for which admission is desired.
 - (v) An interview is held with the candidate who qualifies the written test.
 - (vi) Parents/Gurdian are required to submit the following documents at the time of admission-
- (A) Three passport size photograph, Photocopy of Aadhar Card.
 - (B) Photocopy of birth certificate/original copy of Transfer Certificate.
 - (C) Photocopy of mark sheet of the previous qualification within a week of admission.
 - (D) APAAR ID / PEN Number.

Note: Admission will be cancelled if T.C. is not submitted within a week of admission.



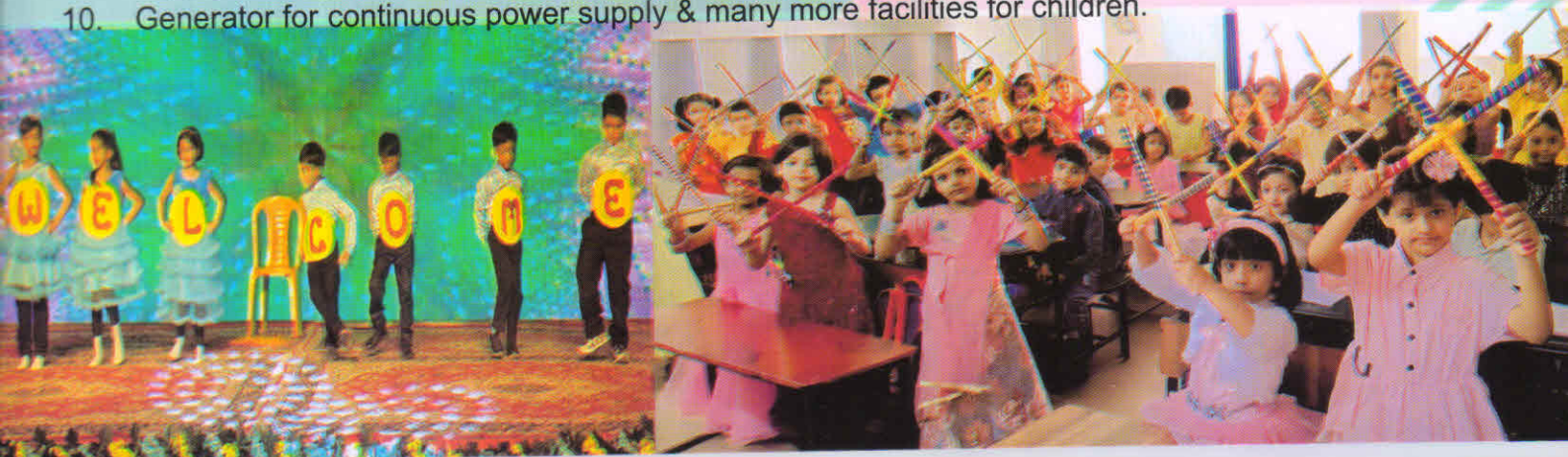
Teaching Staff

The school has well qualified and experienced teaching staff who enables the children to learn and grow in a very healthy and conducive atmosphere. Moreover, weak students are paid close attention. Remedial classes after the school hours are arranged to improve the academic standard of the weak ones. In order to maintain a high standard of education, the school ensures development of its staff through regular upgradation programs in the form of in service education, workshop session, seminars etc. To update teachers with the latest development in the field of education.

Emphasis is laid on the interactive methods and activity based teaching as real learning comes by doing things. The school facilitates exposure of the children to daily life experiences and education through excursions and tours.

Facilities

1. For Play-way, LKG & UKG kids a separate play zone with colorful swings, slides, see-saw etc. is provided
2. Computer games, cartoons, Nursery rhymes, audio-visual aids, Smart Board, huge collection of toys and play-things make their stay at school interesting.
3. A well-stocked Library and reading room.
4. Computer Lab with sufficient number of computers for each student (computer education is provided from class I onwards).
5. A variety of co-curricular activities including sports, cultural programs, debates, quizzes, arts & craft works and science exhibition displaying self made models and charts.
6. Regular free medical check-up.
7. Excursions / Tours & picnics.
8. Subject Enrichment classes are organised to make the students better in solving their difficulties relating every subject.
9. Aquaguard purified potable water.
10. Generator for continuous power supply & many more facilities for children.



Sports

The school has spacious play ground and adequate facilities for providing indoor and outdoor sports activities, recreation and physical education.

Medical & Health

Regular medical examination of students is conducted by the school and a record of weight, height etc is maintained.



Co-curricular Activities

1. All boys and girls are expected to take active part in games, sports, debates and other school activities.
2. Participation in inter house activities and school function is obligatory, failure to participate will be punishable as deemed fit by the Principal.

Conveyance

The school has buses and vans to carry the children safely from each corner of the city to the school and back. Conveyance facility shall not be granted for less than a session.



Mode of Payment

- (i) School and bus fees will be charged for the whole calendar year.
- (ii) Fees should be paid before the 15th of each month. Those, who fail to pay by 30th have to pay a fine of Rs. 50 per month.
- (iii) The names of defaulters will be struck off the rolls on the last day of the month. Re-entry of names in such cases will be made with a re-admission fee of Rs. 50/-along with all the arrears.



School Uniform

SUMMER : MONDAY, TUESDAY, THURSDAY & FRIDAY

BOYS : Half sleeved pink striped shirt with school monogram, Black Full pants (Play-way to class V), or black full pants (class VI onwards) & school socks.

GIRLS : Half sleeved pink striped shirt with school monogram, black tunic (up to knee-length), school socks (Play-way to class V) black ribbon or hair-band, if used.
Full-sleeved pink shirt with school monogram, black skirt up to knee-length (class VI-VIII) black stockings, black ribbon or hair band, if used.

SUMMER : WEDNESDAY & SATURDAY

GIRLS : House T-shirt (Red, Blue, Green or Yellow) with school monogram; white tunic (Play-way to class V), white skirt, white stockings, (Class VI- VIII), white socks (house-wise) white ribbon or hair band, if used.

WINTER : MONDAY, TUESDAY, THURSDAY & FRIDAY

BOYS : Full sleeved pink striped shirt with school monogram, black full pants & school socks.

GIRLS : Full sleeved pink striped shirt with school monogram, black tunic (up to knee-length) White stockings (Girls) (Play-way to V).

Full sleeved pink striped shirt with school monogram, black skirt, White stockings (Girls) (VI to XI).

WINTER : WEDNESDAY & SATURDAY

BOYS : House T-shirt (Red, Blue, Green or Yellow) with school monogram, white full pants & white socks.

GIRLS : House T-shirt (Red, Blue, Green or Yellow) with school monogram; white tunic & white stockings (Play-way to class V), white skirt, white stockings, (Class VI- XI) white socks (house-wise), white ribbon or hair band, if used.

NOTE : As the school uniform is compulsory parents will pay particular attention to the same. Children who are not in uniform will not be allowed to be in the class. Parents will, therefore, kindly provide children with sufficient set of uniforms and see that they come to school neat & tidy.



Examination and Evaluation

The academic year of the school runs from April to March splitted into two terms: first term & second term. The evaluation of the child's development is undertaken based on his or her performance during the academic year. Emphasis is laid on continuous internal assessment, through monthly tests. It therefore, becomes essential for students to be regular and perform well in their daily classes. Besides, the school conducts formal half-yearly & annual examinations at regular intervals to develop in them the competitive ability and assess the skill and knowledge gained by them over the particular period of time.

A pupil, who fails to appear in the annual examination even though he/she had secured sufficient marks in periodical tests and half yearly examination, will be evaluated as failed in the annual examination and shall not be promoted to the next higher class. However, the absence from the annual examination due to reasons beyond the pupil control, he/she may be given promotion to the next class on the recommendation of the Principal, provided he/she has passed in all the other tests and half yearly examination.

In order to qualify for promotion to the higher class, a student has to obtain a minimum of 33% marks in individual subjects.

Attendance & Leave

1. A minimum of 80% attendance is compulsory. Thus, a student who does not maintain 80% attendance for a particular academic session shall not be permitted to appear in the examination nor shall he/she be eligible for promotion.
2. Leave to the pupil for absence is granted only on an application, addressed to the Principal through the class teacher submitted on time (definitely the same day, or the next day in unavoidable circumstances, duly attested by the parent/guardian.
3. The period of leave with reason should also be recorded in the pupil's diary by the parent with signature
4. In case of illness, a Medical Certificate must be attached with the application. Long absence except in case of illness will not be granted normally.
5. If a pupil remains absent from the school for three consecutive days from the day of reopening without forwarding leave application in writing, his/her name will be struck off the rolls. If a pupil remains absent from the school for ten consecutive days without leave application his/her name will be removed from the school rolls.
6. Attendance is compulsory on National Holidays such as Independence Day, Republic Day and on special days such as Teacher's Day, Children's Day, Opening and Closing day of the terms
7. During class hours pupil will not be allowed to go home or elsewhere. In case of some emergency cases the parent of the student will have to come personally to take his/her ward.



Disciplinary Measures

- (a) The following disciplinary measures may be adopted by the school authorities in dealing with errant pupils who indulge in any of the forbidden practice.
1. Warning
 2. Fine
 3. Suspension
 4. Rusticate
- (b) The Principal of the school may warn or impose a fine on the pupil under intimation to his parents or local guardian.

Student's Task Diary (Almanac)

The school provides every student with a student's task diary. This contains information on school songs, prayers, pledges etc. which are rehearsed everyday in the morning assembly. Additionally, the diary contains valuable information useful to students like academic calendar, time-table, notices information about parent-teacher meet, holidays, teacher's remarks on student's performance etc. All these information are of utmost importance to students as well as parents. Since it is always not possible for parents to have a physical meeting with teachers every now and then, the student's diary can act as a powerful tool for communication between school and parents. Parents are therefore, advised to refer to the student's diary on a daily basis and use it for communicating with the school Principal and teachers.
